**INITIAL SCHEDULING CONFERENCE ORDER**

THIS ORDER is entered on June 29, 2011.

Counsel have discussed with the Court their respective need for adequate discovery time, complexity of legal issues to be addressed, and their caseload in arriving at this agreed Scheduling Order.

IT IS ORDERED that the following must be completed within the time fixed:

1. NO APPLICATION TO JOIN ADDITIONAL PARTIES or TO AMEND THE PLEADINGS may be filed after September 30, 2011 without leave of the Court.
2. PRELIMINARY WITNESS & EXHIBIT LISTS exchanged by: To be determined.
3. FACT DISCOVERY must be completed by: November 30, 2012.
4. EXPERT DISCOVERY: To be determined.
5. DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS: To be determined.
6. SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE OR MEDIATION DATE & TIME: To be determined.
7. MOTIONS IN LIMINE must be filed: 30 days prior to Pretrial Conference.
8. PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE DATE & TIME: To be determined.
9. FINAL WITNESS & EXHIBIT LISTS exchanged by: 30 days prior to trial.
10. REQUESTED JURY INSTRUCTIONS must be filed by: 10 days prior to trial.

11. NATURE OF CLAIMS TO BE TRIED: Professional audit negligence. Plaintiff's claims for breach of fiduciary duty and violation of the Accountancy Act are currently subject to Defendant's pending motion to dismiss.
12. TRIAL DATE: To be determined. Jury trial is requested.
13. ESTIMATED TIME FOR TRIAL: To be determined.
14. ADDITIONALLY ORDERED: The parties shall meet and confer beginning in January 2012 on a proposed schedule for the deadlines that remain to be determined. If they cannot reach agreement by February 1, 2012, they shall notify the Court and request a status conference to address the remainder of the schedule.


IT IS ORDERED that no date set by this Order can be changed except for good cause and upon written Order of this Court prior to the date scheduled.


