NOTICE OF FINAL DISTRIBUTION

On June 19, 2017, Bettina M. Whyte, as the Litigation Trustee of the SemGroup Litigation Trust (the "Litigation Trust") caused the Final Distribution to be made to the holders of beneficial interests in the Litigation Trust.

Pursuant to the *Order Approving Litigation Trustee's Motion to Approve Process for Distributions from Litigation Trustee and to Approve Litigation Trustee as Disbursing Agent* [Docket No. 9656], a holder of a beneficial interest has one-hundred and eighty (180) days to negotiate any checks issued by the Litigation Trustee as part of a final distribution. As this distribution is a final distribution, any entitlement to any distribution will become barred on December 18, 2017, which is the first business day which is one hundred and eighty (180) days after the final distribution.

A FAILURE TO TIMELY NEGOTIATE ANY CHECK ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 18, 2017 WILL RESULT IN A BAR TO RE-ISSUANCE OR OTHER PAYMENT.

IF ANY CHECK IS RETURNED AS "UNDELIVERABLE", NO FURTHER DISTRIBUTION WILL BE MADE UNLESS THE LITIGATION TRUSTEE IS NOTIFIED, IN WRITING, BY A HOLDER OR HOLDER'S REPRESENTATIVE OF SUCH HOLDER'S THEN CURRENT ADDRESS. SUCH WRITTEN NOTIFICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BEFORE DECEMBER 18, 2017, WHICH IS THE FIRST BUSINESS DAY WHICH IS ONE-HUNDRED AND EIGHTY (180) DAYS AFTER THE FINAL DISTRIBUTION.
